DIRECTIONS TO TEST:

The Ottawa Fields Trial Grounds are located approximately 5 miles North of Eagle, WI on Rt 67.

- ❖ From the Waukesha Area- Take I-94 West to Hwy 67. Take Hwy 67 South to site, just past the intersection of Hwy 67 and Cty C/106
- ❖ From the Chicago area- Take I-94 to Hwy 67 North through Eagle about 5 miles from the site.
- ❖ From the Janesville-Beloit Area- Take Hwy 15 to Rt 12. Take Rt 12 North to Hwy 67, and Hwy 67 North, about 5 miles from the site.
- ❖ From the Madison Area- Take I-94 East to Hwy 67. Take Hwy 67 south to site, just past the intersection of CTY C/106.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

In accordance with AKC Regulations, entries in this tracking test will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached.

The drawing will be held at the home of the test secretary on Thursday, October 28, 2010 at 7 pm. The drawing is open to the public.

A **worker draw** will be used for this test in accordance with the parameters set forth in Ch 1 Sec 13d of the Tracking Regulations and as determined by the Board of the Moraine Tracking Club and published in the January, 2010 Meeting minutes and Newsletter. Two tracks will be set aside for workers at this test.

This drawing, conducted by the test secretary, shall be completely at random from among the entries received, except that preference shall be given to those entries which have not earned a VST title.

When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the alternate list, subject to the same preferences set forth above.

The test secretary will notify all entries of the result of the drawing within 48 hours by telephone or email. Alternates have the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternate list. Those who opt to decline shall have their entry fees returned upon written notification to the test secretary of their intention to withdraw from the alternate list.

In the event an accepted entry cancels after the closing of entries, the test secretary shall contact alternates in the order of their placement on the alternate list. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option to accept or decline the opportunity to participate in the test.

No entry fee will be refunded except that of an alternate who does not participate in the test. Exception: In the event that an accepted entry withdraws from the test and an alternate replaces that entry, refund will be made to the withdrawn entry.

In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the test secretary to determine if alternates are present, and to determine, by their position on the alternate list, which of the alternates will participate.

BITCHES IN SEASON. Bitches in season will be permitted to run and will be assigned to the last track(s).

The assignment of dogs to the tracks is the responsibility of the judges.

Dogs must be on lead at all times in any area of the tracking site.

Special Notice:

The Ottawa Field Trial Grounds are a part of the Wisconsin State Parks system, and as such a daily or annual permit is required for entry into the grounds. Daily permits may be purchased on site. The daily fee is \$7.00 for residents and \$10.00 for non-residents. Annual and daily permits may also be purchased at any Wisconsin State Park Ranger Station.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
