Dogs who may not Compete:

No dog under the age of 6 months may compete in tracking events
No dog belonging wholly or in part to a judge, test secretary, superintendent, official veterinarian, or any member of such a person's household may be entered in any Tracking Test at which such person officiates or is scheduled to officiate. Nor may they handle or act as agent for any dog entered at that test.

Errors on Entry:

Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in event of errors. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed. Mail both sides of the entry form, and fees, to **Susan Chapman, 9548 Brandt Ave., Oak Lawn, IL 60453-3023**. Make checks payable to **Moraine Tracking Club**. Phone or fax entries will not be accepted. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver. Illegible or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. **Receipt of entries will be acknowledged via email**; please provide a valid email address with entry. 100 percent of entry fees will be refunded (check destroyed) for any reason if written or email withdrawal request is received by the Test Secretary on or before the closing day and time. As required by the AKC Tracking Regulations, **a written certification must accompany the TDU entry for any dog which has not previously passed an AKC TD or TDU test.**

Event Cancellation:

The well-being of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, refund of entry will be made.

Draw:

In accordance with AKC Regulations, entries in this tracking test will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test, and the limit is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks will be exchanged (2 TDU per VST track) up to the limits set by AKC Tracking Regulations (Chapter 1, Sec. 13a). Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the Test will be held at the home of the test secretary on **Thursday, September 9, 2021, at 6 p.m. CDT**. The drawing is open to the public. This drawing, conducted by the test secretary, shall be completely at random from among the entries received, except that preference shall be given to those entries which have not earned a TDU or VST title.

When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the alternate list, subject to the same preferences set forth above. The test secretary will notify all entries of the result of the drawing within 48 hours by telephone or email. Alternates have the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternate list. Those who opt to decline shall have their entry fees returned upon written

notification to the test secretary of their intention to withdraw from the alternate list. In the event an accepted entry cancels after the closing of entries, the test secretary shall contact alternates in the order of their placement on the alternate list. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option to accept or decline the opportunity to participate in the test.

No entry fee will be refunded except that of an alternate who does not participate in the test. Exception: In the event that an accepted entry withdraws from the test and an alternate replaces that entry, refund will be made to the withdrawn entry. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the test secretary to determine if alternates are present, and to determine, by their position on the alternate list, which of the alternates will participate.

Worker Draw:

A worker draw will be used for this test in accordance with the parameters set forth in Ch. 1 Sec. 17d of the current Tracking Regulations and as determined by the Board of the Moraine Tracking Club and published in the January 2010 meeting minutes and newsletter. Up to 1 TDU and 1 VST tracks may be set aside for the workers at this test.

Test Day Draw for Order of Tracks:

The draw will take place at the Test Headquarters with details to be provided on the Judging Program. The Test Secretary must be informed before the draw of any bitches in season and they will be assigned the last track. People cannot act as tracklayers for dogs if, within the last 10 days, they have boarded, laid a track for, or regularly trained the dogs whose tracks they are to lay. The Test Secretary must be notified prior to the drawing of tracks, and the judges will modify the draw to meet the requirements of the tracklayer. The order of the TDU tracks will be drawn on Sunday, September 19, 2021, at 7:15 a.m. The first TDU track will be run promptly at 7:30 a.m. Drawing for VST tracks will be held after the TDU tracks have been judged, but not before 9:15 a.m. local time.

The assignment of dogs to the tracks is the responsibility of the judges. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. If any exhibitor, their dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior, they may, at the discretion of the Test committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made. The Moraine Tracking Club, the Test Committee, the Village of Lincolnshire, Illinois, and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibility for any injury to people or dogs.

Dogs must be on lead at all times in any area of the tracking site. Moraine Tracking Club reserves the right to cancel the test due to extreme weather conditions.

- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. I understand the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-10 at this tracking test held at Lincolnshire Corporate Center, Lincolnshire, Illinois on September 19, 2021 may result from the actions, omissions or negligence of myself and others, including but not limited to The Moraine Tracking Club, show staff, employees, volunteers, participants, attendees and their families. I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge and hold the Moraine Tracking Club, its officers, volunteers, attendees or other participants from any claim.

Social Distancing: I will following the AKC and State of Illinois directives by practicing proper social distancing of 6 feet, hand washing, use of hand sanitizer and wearing a mask at all times when unable to social distance . All attendees should try to park with increased distance between vehicles . Do not touch dogs of other handlers.

Health Reporting: I have not experienced any symptoms of possible COVID-19 in the last 14 days, including cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, feeling feverish or a temperature greater than 100 degrees. I have not had close contact with a person symptomatic or confirmed to have COVID-10 in the last 14 days. I have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days. If I have been infected by COVID-19 at any time, I have been medically released to return to normal activities. If I develop a fever and symptoms, such as cough or difficulty breathing, or if I am diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of this event, I will report this information to The Moraine Tracking Club test secretary.
